REGISTRATION ASSISTANCE

It is the intention of North Delta Minor Hockey Association for all interested families and children in the North Delta Community to have access to the great sport of hockey. Unfortunately, the cost of hockey can leave some families in a position to make difficult financial choices.

NDMHA has set up a fund to assist families who require financial assistance with registration fees. The assistance will be provided to players in Recreation hockey only. The grant does not include other costs associated with hockey such as team fees. The full amount must be applied toward the Association fees in the year that it is awarded.

Application to either the Jump Start Program or Kid Sport must be made first. Once the Registrar receives the cheque from either of these organizations, the remainder of the Association registration fees will be paid using the Registration Assistance Fund. The Registrar will complete a Registration Assistance Form and forward the form and cheque to the Treasurer.

Names of players and parents receiving registration assistance will be treated as confidential information. The total number of players utilizing registration assistance must not exceed one percent (1%) of the total number of registrants in a given year.
