Welcome to North Delta Minor Hockey

North Delta Hockey is a non-profit society created to provide the children of our community, ages 5 through 20, with the opportunity to play league hockey in an environment that promotes and teaches all aspects of the sport of hockey. Ice scheduling, coach assigning and association organizational duties require that registration take place well in advance of the hockey season. Registrations are processed as they are received and waiting lists will be kept as necessary.

How to Register

- Complete and sign the new player registration checklist
- Complete and sign the new player registration form
- Please provide a photocopy of player's birth certificate and TWO CURRENT proofs of North Delta residency (full page) such as a photocopy of: BC Hydro statement, Fortis Gas statement, Cable, or Property Tax notice (phone bills are not accepted)
- Registration will open on June 15, 2023.
- Registration fees may be paid by cheque(s); cash will not be accepted.

How to Pay

- If paying by installments, cheques may be made for July 15, August 15 and September 15

Refund Policy

- See our website for refund form and instructions. No refunds will be processed until October 1 and no funds after December 1.

Further Information About Registration Fees

- For families with three children registered in ND Hockey: U7 to U18 will receive a \$100 discount that will apply to your youngest child. (Note: U6 is already discounted for all players and is not eligible).
- Goalies (U11 Division and above) who supply their own equipment are entitled to a \$100 goalie rebate. Rebate request must be received **before February 1**. See "Forms" tab on website under "management forms".
- The custodial parent is responsible for signing of all forms and all financial responsibilities
- The custodial parent's residential address determines eligibility to play in ND Hockey. Custody agreements may be required to be forwarded to PCAHA for approval.

U21 Jersey Deposit

- U21 players have a \$200 jersey deposit (included in the registration fee) that is refundable at end of season when jersey is returned.

Rental of Goalie Equipment

- ND Hockey provides goalie equipment to rent for the current season for interested members. This rental fee is an individual responsibility. Please inquire with the Equipment Manager (equipmentmanager@ndhockey.com) regarding the procedures for rental.

On Ice Officials

- ND Hockey welcomes both returning and new officials to its program. If you are second year U13, 12 years of age or older and would like to become an on-ice official, please contact our Referee in Chief at ric@ndhockey.com. The number of new officials this year will be limited.

Equipment and Equipment Check

- All equipment must be purchased prior to the start of the season. Please check the website for more details on equipment requirements.
- Prior to Rep Tryouts and/or Player Evaluations, all members will be required to have an equipment check by our Team Officials to ensure all required equipment is present.

Team Fees *Team fees are in addition to registration fees*

- Team fees are determined following team formation through a budget proposal. The budget is presented by team officials, and agreed to by a majority of parents. These fees must be paid by the end of the season. Failure to comply may place the non-compliant member in a "**member not in good standing**" status which could result in the forfeiting of all rights of that member.

Team Placement – U6 - U9

- If you would like to request a team placement, a separate letter stating specific reasons must accompany this registration form. Both families must submit a separate letter. ND Hockey cannot guarantee that all requests will be granted.

Rep Teams – U11, U13, U15, U18 and U21

- All players should be committed to performing to their best ability. It should be every Rep player's goal to play at the top tier of our Association. Families should fully consider the commitment of Rep level hockey when registering. Rep players must play within their correct age group (division). Movement between divisions is not permitted.

Rep Tryouts

- Any player who will not be available at this time must inform the 1st Vice President at vp1@ndhockey.com in writing prior to the commencement of tryouts.

Major and Minor Zone Teams

- Please see BC Hockey website www.bchockey.net for more information regarding the Major and Minor Zone Leagues.
- If an ND Rep team has not taken the max roster as defined by Hockey Canada, a player can petition to the VP1 to ask to be added to a Rep team. No players will be allowed to be added to a team after Dec 15th. The addition of the player is up to the discretion of the Head coach of the team and the VP1. If the player is added they are required to pay rep tryout fees, full registration fees, and pro-rated team fees.

Players Attending Junior Camps

- Players should still register for ND Minor Hockey.
- If an ND Rep team has not taken the max roster as defined by Hockey Canada, a player can petition to the VP1 to ask to be added to a Rep team. No players will be allowed to be added to a team after Dec 15th. The addition of the player is up to the discretion of the Head coach of the team and the VP1. If the player is added they are required to pay rep tryout fees, full registration fees, and pro-rated team fees.

Medical Information Forms

- Each season players will need to submit a medical information form. The information is kept for the current season only to provide emergency information to the team HCSP's. New information will be collected each season.
