### Welcome to North Delta Minor Hockey

North Delta Minor Hockey Association (NDMHA) is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing children and youth in our community, ages 5 through 20, the opportunity to participate in organized hockey in a positive, safe and development-focused environment.

Our goal is to promote:

- Teamwork and sportsmanship
- Respect for teammates, coaches, officials, and the game
- Community involvement and lifelong participation in hockey

Ice scheduling, coach assignments, evaluations, and association planning require registrations to take place well in advance of the hockey season.

Registrations are processed in the order they are received. Waiting lists will be maintained where necessary.

### What Your Registration Fees Cover

Registration fees help support the operation and development of hockey programs within NDMHA and include:

- Ice rental and facility costs
- Membership in governing hockey associations
- Association administration
- League fees
- Hockey insurance for players, coaches, referees, and trainers
- Player development programming
- Referee payments for league games (U8–U21)

### Refund Policy

- Refund forms and instructions are available on the NDMHA website.
- No refunds will be processed prior to October 1.
- No refunds will be issued after December 1.

## Family Discounts

Families registering three children with NDMHA in divisions U7–U18 will receive a **\$100 discount** applied to the youngest child.

*Please note: U6 registration is already discounted and is not eligible for this program.*

## Goalie Rebate

Goalies in U11 and above who supply their own equipment are eligible for a **\$350 goalie rebate**.

- Rebate requests must be submitted before February 1.
- Please see the “Management Forms” section on the website.

## U21 Jersey Deposit

U21 registration includes a **\$200 jersey deposit**.

This deposit is refundable at the end of the season once the jersey has been returned.

## Rental of Goalie Equipment

NDMHA offers goalie equipment rentals for the current hockey season.

## On-Ice Officials Program

NDMHA welcomes both returning and new officials to our officiating program

Eligibility Requirements:

- Minimum second-year U13 player
- Must be at least 12 years old

## Equipment Requirements & Safety Checks

- All required hockey equipment must be purchased prior to the start of the season.
- Please refer to the NDMHA website for full equipment requirements.

## Team Fees

Team fees are separate from registration fees.

After teams are formed:

- Team officials prepare a proposed budget
- Budgets are reviewed and approved by the majority of team parents
- Team fees must be paid by the end of the season

Failure to comply with team financial obligations may result in a member being declared **“not in good standing”**, which could affect future participation rights.

## Rep Teams – U11, U13, U15 & U18

Rep hockey requires a higher level of commitment from players and families.

Families should carefully consider:

- Time commitment
- Travel expectations
- Additional team fees
- Competitive level expectations

Players participating in Rep hockey:

- Must compete within their correct age division
- Cannot move between divisions
- Are expected to perform to the best of their ability

If an NDMHA Rep team has not reached the maximum roster size defined by Hockey Canada:

- A player may petition the VP1 for placement on a Rep team
- No players may be added after December 15
- Final approval is at the discretion of the Head Coach and VP1

Approved players are responsible for:

- Rep tryout fees
- Full registration fees
- Pro-rated team fees

## Players Attending Junior Camps

Players attending Junior Camps are still encouraged to register with NDMHA.

Should roster space become available on a Rep team:

- Players may petition the VP1 for placement
- No additions are permitted after December 15
- Approval is determined by the Head Coach and VP1

Approved players are responsible for:

- Rep tryout fees
- Full registration fees
- Pro-rated team fees

### **Medical Information Forms**

All players are required to submit a medical information form each season.

This information:

- Is used for emergency purposes only
- Is accessible only to authorized team HCSP personnel
- Is retained for the current season only

Updated medical information must be submitted each season.
